### **Executive Summary**

In the D3.4 of WP3, two regional training workshops were planned to be held during the CLIMASP project. The workshops were very practical oriented and focused on the exchange concerning the different development stages of the CLIMASP minor programme between the project partners in Egypt, Jordan and Lebanon. Partners from Greece, Cyprus and Germany provided feedback and tried to support the development phases. Particular emphasis was placed on the structure and function of the CLIMASP minor & course modules, financial and administrative issues as well as discussions on the achievements, drawbacks and other issues related to the CLIMASP project. Initially, the 1st Regional Training Workshop was planned to be carried in Egypt, but due to the political instability in this country, it was decided to move it to Jordan. It was hosted by the American University of Madaba and Jerash Private University from 25-27 October 2014. For the same reasons, the 2nd Regional Training Workshop was moved again to Cyprus, hosted by Frederick University, in May, 5-8, 2016. Participation in

the 1st and 2nd regional teacher training sessions ranged from 50 to 70 participants. Besides these number, external stakeholders were invited and take part, ranged from 10-15.

## 1<sup>st</sup> Regional Training Workshop in Jordan

The first regional training workshop took place in Jordan at the University of Jordan, the American University of Madaba and Jerash Private University from 25-27 October 2014. The focus of the workshop was on the development of the course syllabi and course modules. Each partner university from Egypt, Lebanon and Jordan presented the structure of their CLIMASP minor and the course modules, which was followed by a discussion. The syllabi and modules were peer-reviewed by another partner institution, which led the discussion and also presented their impressions.

Thus the objective of the workshop was the presentation of and exchange about the CLIMASP course syllabi and modules. By listening to the modules of other partner institutions, partners could get inspired also for developing their own modules. Exchange, constructive feedback and discussions about the modules were key of the workshop.

Additionally, the project coordinator addressed specific project management tasks, especially related to funding issues.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Regional training workshop, Cyprus

The second regional training workshop took place at Frederick University in Nicosia, Cyprus from 5-7 May 2016. The workshop focused on the exchange concerning the first results of the implemented CLIMASP minor programs at the partner universities in Jordan, Egypt and Lebanon.

The workshop started with welcome sessions and presentations about the host university, a Master Course on Education for Environment and Sustainable Development and its nature conservation unit. Afterwards the progress of the CLIMASP project was presented by the project coordinator, followed by presentations about the implementation of the minor program at the different partner universities. For example partners have developed implementation strategies, where they describe its objectives and measures of how to reach them, define timelines or implementation tools. Results showed that students, who were enrolled in the

CLIMASP minor continued their interests in climate change issues and gained a deeper understanding of climate change. Responses were positive and interaction among students could be increased. The minor will also raise awareness of sustainability issues. Curriculum issues and how to integrate gender aspects were discussed as well. Partners also presented their dissemination activities, including various levels such as informing students and interested people (via websites, social media, brochures, workshops, student projects or orientation weeks), capacity building of teaching staff, presentations in international conferences, writing research papers for discussions among the academic community or dissemination activities in newspapers or television channels.

The external evaluator presented its results and insights, the CLIMASP Minor EuroArabpass Certificates were awarded and the Pedoulas Environmental Center was visited. The second day closed with a cultural tour around Pedoulas. The final workshop day was dedicated to administrative and financial issues, where the project coordinator informed about the final financial audit and the partners had the opportunity for national consulting sessions.
