The EuroArabPass

EuroArabPass is a new initiative which aims first to reward the CLIMASP students with a diploma supplement and second to disseminate the concept to all higher education graduates in the Middle East and North African (MENA) region. This is very important to make their skills and qualifications clearly and easily understood in Europe, the Arab world and worldwide.

During the CLIMASP period we had several discussions with our partners, especially in key events. Through these discussions we have deepened the initial conception of the EuroArabPass and its importance. EuroArabPass has a number of benefits associated with it, such as:

- Helps to convey qualifications and competences in an effective way
- Gives better access to opportunities for study, training and employment throughout Europe and the MENA region.
- Links higher education with community, business and industry.
- Brings transparency and visibility of academic qualifications and associated experiences.

As it is contextualised from the Europass supplement, it consists of four documents adapted and contextualised from the Europass, namely:

- EuroArabPass Diploma Supplement - a personal document issued to higher education graduates that records in detail the holder's education qualifications. It is used as a supplement to an academic degree or diploma.
- EuroArabPass CV - it enables higher education graduates to make their qualifications and competences more visible.
- EuroArabPass Mobility - a record of any organised study period spent in European and other foreign higher education institutions as well as work placements and internships.
- EuroArabPass Language Portfolio - a document in which language qualifications and competences are recorded.
